During the 1840's, whaling constituted the lifeblood of New England's economy. Hardy sailing men on strong vessels manned the North Atlantic hunting these giant animals, which were later processed for oil. Whaling ships replaced the older method of sighting and harpooning whales from the land, with the use of these vessels, the whalers could sail directly to where the whales were. The Wanderer is representative of these hardy vessels that ruled the Atlantic.
